WORLD DAY OF PRAYER ENGLAND, WALES & NORTHERN IRELAND

MISSION STATEMENT

As representatives of the churches in England, Wales & Northern Ireland, and members of a world-wide, womenled, ecumenical prayer movement, we work to promote *'informed prayer, prayerful action'* through the production of materials to support the annual international prayer service.

We encourage women to plan ecumenically for the World Day of Prayer, promoting prayerful living and worship for men, women and young people and helping raise awareness of the lives and concerns of others throughout the world, especially those who write the service. Through these activities we support Christian charities which provide practical help for people in need.

On the First Friday in March every year a service is held where a chosen country produces materials for the world to worship. As the materials are written the World Day of Prayer motto

INFORMED PRAYER, PRAYERFUL ACTION

is set in motion. World Day of Prayer is a prayer movement, not for just one day a year but throughout the year. World Day of Prayer, a worldwide, women-led, ecumenical Prayer Movement.

Please use this monthly prayer diary to help you focus on the prayer needs of the Movement and add your local needs in the space provided each week.

SEPTEMBER

At the start of this diary year please remember in your prayers all the charities who have received grants from WDP. Check the WDP website for information on the charities helped and on the charity of the month.

Wk1: Distribution of new materials to all branches begins.

Pray for the people packing the parcels and for the post

people and couriers delivering them. Pray for the safe arrival of the materials.
Wk2: The Preparation Days begin. Pray for safe journeys to the events and that the information given on the days is useful in the preparation of the service. Pray also for the organisers of the day and for the National Committee members attending.

Wk3: Finance and National Committee meetings take place this week.

As the committee members travel from around England, Wales & N Ireland pray for safe journeys. Pray for wisdom for the Finance sub-Committee as they discuss the grant applications received and how to distribute the money available. Pray for unity in decisions made; for the charities helped; and also, for those applications which were not successful, pray that they may receive their needs from other sources.
Wk4: WDP Office Pray for the new office staff as they continue to learn more about WDP and their roles; for them as they continue to pack and send out stock and preparation day parcels; pray for the Administrator as she prepares the minutes from the meetings and sends out the good news to the grant recipients.

OCTOBER

Wk1: Grant recipients past and present Continue to pray for all the charities that WDP has helped over the years. May they be blessed in all that they do showing Christian love throughout the world.
Wk2: WDP International Executive Committee Pray for the WDP International Executive Committee made up of representatives from seven different areas of the world. Pray that these volunteers continue to grow in their role on the Executive Committee and enjoy fellowship with their fellow members around the world.

Wk3: WDP Branches As materials are received around the country pray for the meetings that are being held to discuss the new materials. Pray for the Branch Secretaries as they arrange these meetings and pray for the local committee members as they begin to learn about the next Day of Prayer.
Wk4: WDP Residential Preparations Pray for the National Committee as they receive the materials which will be worked on at the residential meeting in November. Pray as they read and digest the information that ideas will be forthcoming.

Wk1: Preparation Days
As the preparation days are in full swing continue to pray for the organisers of the events. Pray for good fellowship as local committees meet together to learn more about the next Day of Prayer.
Wk2: WDP Taiwan
Pray for the World Day of Prayer Committee in Taiwan as the world begins to look at their service. Pray that they start to feel the wave of prayer coming their way leading up to the Day of Prayer 2023.

Wk3: WDP National Committee England, Wales & Northern Ireland Residential Meeting As the National Committee meet for this week-long residential pray for their safe travel to King's Park Conference Centre, Northampton. Pray for good fellowship, understanding and unity as meetings are held and work is started on the materials for the 2024 service.
Wk4: WDP Welsh Committee Pray for the WDP Welsh Committee and their preparations for the service in Welsh. Pray that the Welsh speaking preparation days are successful. Pray for safe travel to the days and for blessed fellowship during their time together.
Wk5: WDP International Executive Committee Chairperson Pray for the new Chairperson as she settles into her job leading the Executive Committee and helping the countries that are preparing the service in the future.

DECEMBER

Wk4: Christmas Pray for all volunteers and charities particularly at this time of year who are helping where people are desperate for what foodbanks have to offer; where homeless shelters are over-flowing; and where people are giving up their time to serve Christmas dinner to those people on their own or in need.

JANUARY

Wk1: New year, new commitments Pray for new beginnings, new friendships, and new fellowship. Pray also that the goodwill shown in past weeks can continue; that those helped will continue to be helped; and pray that the busy people can find the
time to rest.
Wk2: Meeting Rooms, London Pray for the buildings that the National Committee will be using for their meetings throughout the year. Pray for those who provide the refreshments, including lunch, and for all those who work in the buildings.

Wk3: National Committee Meetings Pray for safe travel for the National Committee members as they attend the meetings in London. Pray especially for the Publications meeting as the printing of the Palestine materials is discussed.
Wk4: WDP Albania This week we pray for Merita Meko and the ladies of Albania as they prepare for their workshop looking at the materials for the Taiwan service. We pray for their
safety, their freedom to worship and for good fellowship.
Wk5: WDP materials for the next Day of Prayer As the drafts are updated and circulated pray that all comes together well and that photos are chosen and appropriate verses are found for the cards.

FEBRUARY

Give thanks for all they do in distributing the materials around the world and give thanks for their dedication to the World Day of Prayer Movement.
Wk4: Preparations for the World Day of Prayer Pray that last minute preparations for the Day of Prayer go well.

Wk4: WDP Palestine Pray for the National Committee of Palestine and all those involved in preparing the materials for the 2024 service. As the information begins to be circulated for the 2024 Day of Prayer, may they all feel the prayer and love being sent to them.

AUGUST

Wk5: Overseas Branches Pray for the branches of WDP England, Wales and Northern Ireland that are overseas. Pray that, as they receive the materials for the next service, they will be able to share them with many people and that those people will enjoy learning more about Palestine.
