

ABIDE HOUSING AT GREEN LAKE

Frequently Asked Questions – updated 3/5/24

What type of rooms are available?

- Green Lake Conference Center offers the following types of housing:
 - House / cottage
 - Hotel
 - Dorms
- There are elevators in the hotels. However, there are some stairs in the houses and cottages.

Is there ADA Compliant housing?

- Yes. However, it is **limited** and on a *first come, first served basis*.
- There will be a place on the registration page for delegates to indicate a need for ADA compliant housing. Please only request this if you truly need ADA.

Do I need to bring my own bedding and towels?

- Bedding and towels are provided in all houses, cottages, hotels, and one of dorm units.
- The last space we will fill will be the youth dorms (similar to camp youth cabins). Those have bunk beds, hallway bathrooms, and no bedding or towels provided.
- All housing will be filled on a *first come, first served basis*.

Can I pick my room or where I stay?

- Unfortunately, No. All housing assignments will be made by THQ. We will take all considerations into account but cannot guarantee anything other than you will have a place to sleep, you will not be sharing a bed, and you will have a roommate.
- Corps may request their delegates stay together in a house / cottage at registration. We will best to keep everyone together.

Can I have a private room?

- With limited space, we are not able to guarantee private rooms. Most rooms have at least two beds per room so prepare to share!

Can I request a roommate?

- Yes! During the online registration process, there is an option to list who you would like to room with. Please add all names there. There is a 500-character limit. Please email us if you cannot fit everyone into the text box: **USC.THQ.WomensMinistries@USC.Salvationarmy.org**.

I'm bringing my nursing baby, where do they sleep?

- All children must be **0-12 months old**. Children over 12 months will not be permitted.
- The conference center does not provide any bedding, cribs, etc. for babies. You will have to bring everything necessary for you and your child.
- If you will be attending with more than one child, we ask that you let THQ know.
